

2020 Census Step-by-Step Walkthrough

Completing the 2020 Census will take only about 10 minutes. This walk through provides additional explanation for each of the questions you will see. Please consider the following before beginning:

- Check with other members of the household who may have already responded and included you.
- You can also complete this questionnaire through a mobile device.

STEP 1

Go to: https://my2020census.gov/ Click on: "Start Questionnaire"

Welcome to the 2020 Census


- It's quick and easy. The 2020 Census questionnaire will take about 10 minutes to complete.
- It's safe, secure, and confidential. Your information and privacy are protected.
- Your response helps to direct billions of dollars in federal funds to local communities for schools, roads, and other public services.
- Results from the 2020 Census will be used to determine the number of seats each state has in Congress and your political representation at all levels of government.

Getting started:

- You must complete your questionnaire once you begin. If you leave the questionnaire and return later, you will have to start over.
- Do not use the web browser buttons (back, forward, or close browser). Use the buttons within the questionnaire to navigate.
- For best results, use the latest version of Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, or Safari. Enable cookies.




Note that the Census wants to know where you will be on <u>April 1, 2020.</u> Click "Next" to continue.




STEP 3

Most addresses in Eagle Mountain have a North, South, East, or West in front of the Street Name. If you are unsure what to enter for your address, the next screen will verify your address. If you still need help, go to the <u>City Map</u> and search your address there. The results will display N, S, E, or W for your property.




Verify your Address, then click "Submit."




STEP 5

Enter your name and telephone number. This will be the ONLY time you need to enter your name.



A new screen will prompt you to begin answering questions about your household. Press "Start" to begin.




STEP 7


Enter the total number of people living or STAYING at the address on April 1st. This can include relatives, foreign exchange students, etc. Click the link to see more examples. When in doubt, include everyone in the home.



Enter the names of all OTHER people in the household. You do not need to enter your name again. Number of rows is based on the number you entered in the previous screen. You can Add or Remove rows using the buttons provided.




Verify you have entered all people correctly. If something is incorrect, click on the "Previous" button.




STEP 10

Indicate the ownership status of the home.




Indicate which individuals own the home.




STEP 12

You can now proceed to answer questions about individuals in the home. Select "Start" next to an individual to begin.



For each individual, you will provide the individuals sex.



STEP 14

For each individual, you will provide the birthdate. The age will automatically populate.




For each individual, you will indicate if they are of Hispanic, Latino, or Spanish origin.

This question has confused or surprised some. When entering race, you are also asked what your racial origin is. You must enter an origin to continue. If you are unsure, give your best guess.


Home > Sex > Age > Hispanic Origin > Race

Select one or more boxes AND enter origins. For this census, Hispanic origins are not races.
White Enter, for example, German, Irish, English, Italian, Lebanese, Egyptian, etc.

You will then be asked how the individual is related to you if related at all.




STEP 18
