RESOLUTION NO. R 01-2004

**A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH
ESTABLISHING ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY
UTILITY SERVICE CHARGE ABATEMENT**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah finds that it is in the public interest to acknowledge the vital contribution of active duty military personnel to the defense and well being of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the City Council understands and acknowledges the financial sacrifice military personnel and their dependants when involved in active duty military service; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to abate utility service charges, where possible, to provide financial relief for families of military service personnel on active duty.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah as follows:

Section 1. This Resolution shall be effective as of the first billing period following January 1, 2004, and shall continue in force and effect until amended or repealed.

Section 2. The abatement provided by this Resolution shall be available to military personnel deployed on active duty and their dependants who are applicants for City water, natural gas and/or electrical power utility services. Qualifying personnel or their dependants shall provide a copy of the military orders activating or deploying military service personnel to the City Utility billing department for filing of record in the City to demonstrate qualification for the abatements provided by this Resolution.

Section 3. Qualifying applicants for the active duty military utility abatement program established by this Resolution shall be entitled to abatement of 100% the base fee charged by the City for water, natural gas, and electrical power for each month of service provided by the City during the period of active duty and for sixty (60) days following return from

active duty. Qualified applicants for the program shall pay only the actual utility actual use charge, not including the base fee for the water, natural gas, and electrical power utility services described in this Resolution.
