

## Resolution Number 97-3

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN UTAH COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND THE TOWN OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN TO PROVIDE PEACE OFFICERS TO PRESERVE THE PUBLIC PEACE.

**Whereas** the town of Eagle Mountain needs the services of a trained and qualified Police Officers to preserve the public peace, prevent crime, detect and arrest offenders, suppress riots, protect persons and property, remove nuisances existing in public streets, roads, and highways, enforce every law relating to the suppression of offenses, and perform all duties required of them by ordinance or resolution: and

**Whereas**, the town has not yet appointed a marshal or ex-officio Chief of Police and does not presently have a police force or any law enforcement officers, but desires to contract with the COUNTY for the purpose of authorizing and appointing the Utah County Sheriff and his deputies as the Police Force for the TOWN: and

**Whereas**, the COUNTY is agreeable to rendering such services on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth:

**Now therefore be it ordained** by the Town Council of Eagle Mountain that:

1. The attached County Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for police protection be approved by the Town Council of Eagle Mountain.
