## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH, EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR A JOINT LAND USE STUDY AMONG CAMP WILLIAMS AND THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS, it is mutually recognized that the continued operation of Camp Williams is important to national defense and to the economies of the State of Utah and central Utah; and

WHEREAS, the Parties executing this Resolution intend to engage in a cooperative planning effort, known as a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS), to guide further community growth and development that is compatible with the mission of Camp Williams; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that participation in and development of the JLUS would also benefit the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of central Utah; and

WHEREAS, on <u>March 15 2010</u> Eagle Mountain City was designated to serve as the sponsoring agency for the JLUS and to apply for designated funding from the Department of Defense;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Parties executing this Resolution shall participate in the Camp Williams Joint Land Use Study and commit to a good-faith effort to implement the Joint Land Use Study recommendations.
