

**TOWN OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN
RESOLUTION NO. 07-99**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING RECREATION
PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT STANDARDS**

WHEREAS, the Town of Eagle Mountain finds that it is in the public interest to provide recreational opportunities for its citizens of all ages; and

WHEREAS, playground and park areas are required improvements in residential development areas; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to establish standards for improvements and playground equipment required to be installed in public parks for use by the public; and

WHEREAS, the Town has reviewed various improvement alternatives and playground equipment and desires to establish standards for improvements to neighborhood parks and for the purchase and installation of playground equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Eagle Mountain, Utah as follows:

Section 1. Each neighborhood park approved for construction and development within residential areas shall be improved according to the following required facility minimum standards:

<i>Required Facilities</i>	<i>Minimum Standards</i>
Play Ground Equipment (single multi age playground equipment)	1 in each neighborhood park
Play Ground Equipment (both age groups of equipment)	1 of each if park is within 1320 feet of more than 150 homes
Pavilion (180 sf)	1 per 150 homes
Bar-be-que	1 per 75 homes
Trails	Connectivity throughout park area
Bicycle Rack	1 per 15 homes

Volley Ball Pit	1 per 150 homes
Landscaping Improvements	Entire Park Area
Trees	1 tree per 3500 sf of park
Picnic Tables	1 per 25 homes

Section 2. Required and approved standard playground park equipment is set forth on Exhibit "1" to this resolution. Exhibit "1" depicts the standard for residential park playground equipment and park playground equipment shall not be approved or accepted other than equipment defined in Exhibit "1" or equipment which is the equivalent of park equipment described in Exhibit "1." The Town Engineer shall review playground equipment nominated as equivalent playground equipment and shall not approve park playground equipment which is not equal to, in function and quality, the standard equipment described on Exhibit "1."

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Eagle Mountain, Utah.
