

**TOWN OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN
RESOLUTION NO. 10-99**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN, UTAH
PROVIDING FOR ALTERNATIVE COMPENSATION
PAYMENT TO ELECTED OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Eagle Mountain, Utah has approved limited compensation for elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Town and individual elected officials to provide alternative methods of payment of compensation; and

WHEREAS, a small per diem payment to elected officials payable for attendance at specific meetings is a fair and equitable alternative method of compensation.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Eagle Mountain, Utah as follows:

Section 1. Elected officials and Public Works Board members entitled to compensation under prior resolutions of the Council, may elect to receive compensation in the form of a per diem payment in lieu of the existing authorized compensation.

Section 2. Per diem payments to elected officials under the terms of this resolution shall not exceed in any single month the total compensation otherwise payable under prior resolutions of the Council authorizing compensation to elected officials.

Section 3. Each per diem payment shall be limited to a payment for each day an elected official attends a meeting as an elected official of the Town requiring a time commitment of more than two (2) hours by the elected official; that the total amount of compensation payable for any single month shall not exceed the monthly compensation limit approved by the Council.

This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption by the Town Council of Eagle Mountain, Utah.
