

**RESOLUTION NO. R 12-2003**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004 FOR EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of Eagle Mountain City has determined that it is in the public interest to increase the tax levy for municipal purposes and has properly advertised and conducted a public hearing on the proposed tax increase taking in to consideration the comments of taxpayers and interested parties; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the needs of public safety require additional tax revenues for the support of law enforcement and fire and emergency services and the City intends to levy a property tax on all properties within the City and to comply with the requirements of Utah Law and adopt the tax rate described herein

**Section 1.** **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Eagle Mountain City approves, enacts and adopts a property tax rate of 0.001692 for the year 2003.

**Section 2.** This Resolution is adopted after truth in taxation notice, public hearing and proper notice and budget hearing and in accordance with applicable state statutes.


**Section 3.** This Resolution shall be forwarded to the County Auditor and the State Tax Commission in accordance with UCA 59-2-913 and 59-2-920.

**Section 4.** This Resolution shall become effective on 1 July, 2003 for the 2003-2004 fiscal year.


**Section 5.** This Resolution will take effect immediately upon enactment.
