

**RESOLUTION NO. R-12-2015**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH,  
DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Eagle Mountain City Code describes the requirements for disposal of surplus property; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined by professional staff that the property listed in Exhibit A should be declared surplus and sold; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City, Utah as follows:


1. The property more specifically described in Exhibit A is hereby declared surplus property.
2. The value of the equipment may be determined by one or more of the following methods to determine the highest and best economic return to the City:
  - a. advertised competitive bid;
  - b. evaluation by a qualified and disinterested appraiser;
  - c. other professional publication and valuation service; or
  - d. an informal market survey by the City Administrator or a designee.
3. Any monetary proceeds from the sale will be credited to the General Fund.


