RESOLUTION 18-2006

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH
CREATING A SENIOR CITIZEN ADVISORY COUNCIL**

Preamble

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to create a Senior Citizen Advisory Council in Eagle Mountain City; and

WHEREAS, establishment of a Senior Citizen Advisory Council to the City Council will provide information on issues of importance to Senior Citizens and recommendations for programs and facilities for Senior Citizens to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City as follows:

1. A Senior Citizen Advisory Council for Eagle Mountain City is hereby created comprised of five (5) members, appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the City Council.
2. The members appointed to the Senior Citizen Advisory Council shall serve terms of 4 years each. The initial term of two (2) members shall be designated by the Mayor to stagger the initial terms of office to provide one 2 year first term, two 3 year terms, and two 4 year terms.
3. Members of the Senior Citizen Advisory Council are authorized to consider, investigate and explore all aspects of issues, programs and facilities of importance to Senior Citizens of Eagle Mountain, and make recommendations to the City Council for the planning and accomplishment of programs and facilities for Senior Citizens. The Senior Citizen Advisory Council may also establish contact with state and federal authorities to provide funding, expertise or other assistance for cemetery facility planning, operation, construction, construction and development, but may not conduct binding negotiations on behalf of the City without formal authorization by the City Council.
4. The Senior Citizen Advisory Council will select annually a Chairperson from among its members by majority vote. The Chairperson will be responsible for arranging convenient times and places for meetings of the Senior Citizen Advisory Council, providing notice of



such meetings to all members. The Senior Citizen Advisory Council may, in its discretion, schedule public hearings for the purpose of receiving comments and information. Public hearings will be advertised to the community by posting at the City Hall and by notice in a paper of general circulation not less than 14 days in advance.

5. For the purposes of this Resolution, Senior Citizens are persons of 50 years of age and older.
6. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.


