A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING FOR ADOPTION OF THE FINAL BUDGET

- 1. The Redevelopment Agency hereby adopts the tentative budget attached as Exhibit A.
- 2. The Redevelopment Agency will conduct a public hearing to review the final budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 on May 21, 2019, directly following the City Council meeting scheduled at 7:00 p.m.
- 3. The Redevelopment Agency plans to adopt the final budget for fiscal year 2019-2020 on June 18, 2019.
