

## **RESOLUTION NO. R-02-2022**

### **A RESOLUTION OF EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY, UTAH, SUPPORTING THE UTAH BROADBAND ACCESS GRANT APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT A FIBER OPTIC NETWORK IN WHITE HILLS TO PROVIDE EXPANDED ACCESS TO HIGH-SPEED BROADBAND INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE TO EAGLE MOUNTAIN CITY RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES**

#### *PREAMBLE*

WHEREAS, the State of Utah, through the Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity, Utah Broadband Center, has made \$10,000,000 in grant funds available to eligible applicants to fund broadband projects in unserved and underserved areas of the State through the Utah Broadband Access Grant (the "Grant"); and

WHEREAS, significant geographic areas and many households in Eagle Mountain City, Utah (the "City") do not have reliable high-speed internet access, and the construction, installation, and maintenance of an expanded broadband network in the City would allow greater access to educational opportunities, medical and mental health management, social interaction, recreational and entertainment opportunities, and economic development throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, a competitive local internet service provider seeks to apply for Grant funds to construct a network in the City to improve broadband service and the quality of life for residents and business owners in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that the Utah Broadband Access Grant is extremely competitive, and applicants are required to demonstrate support for proposed projects from the local governing body, and

WHEREAS, the City fully supports the Grant application to improve broadband access in the City.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Eagle Mountain City that Eagle Mountain City fully supports the application for Grant funds for the purpose of upgrading and expanding broadband service in the City.
