EMC strongly recommends planting in October or November as weather permits. Seedings that don't take because they were planted in the spring or summer will need to be replanted. Seeded areas will be inspected mid summer post planting. We recommend using a drill seeder or broadcasting seed on the area to be reseeded, if areial broadcasting, we recommend the soild be disturbed before seeding and or have a light layer of topsoil spread over the top of the seeding. Seed mix needs to be at the rate of 20lbs per acre. Seed mixes may differ from mix above BUT must include a minimun of; 4 species of grass listed above (one has to be siberian wheatgrass) 5 species of forbs (of which one has to be falcata alfalfa). Any shrubs (recommended @50/acre) must be bare root stalk or potted shrubs.
